Good Time Credits provide incentive for incarcerated individuals to comply with governing policies in a measureable way which allows them to demonstrate they are truly transformed and prepared to reenter society.

GOOD TIME ASKS



30 day credit for 30 days served



All sentences with numbers will receive a reduction to Minimums & Maximums sentence lengths



No Credit Earned for Month that an individual receives a Class 1 Misconduct



Retroactive for all currently serving and future incarcerated individuals
